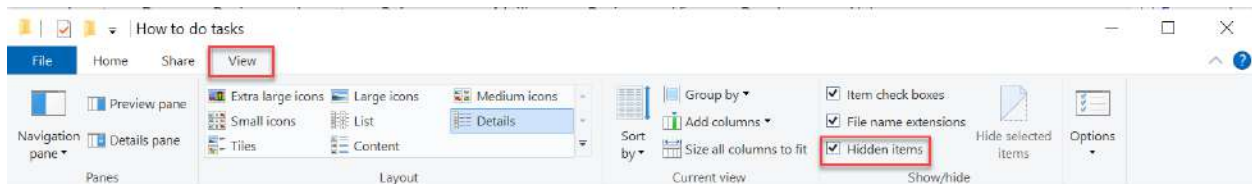


How to Access Solidworks Templates from the 3D Experience Platform

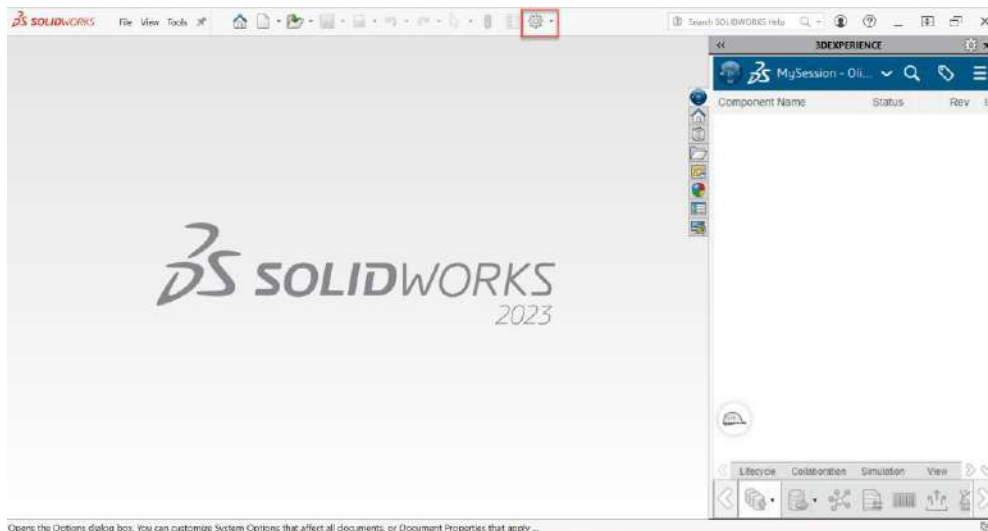
Before you try to access templates from the 3D Experience Platform make sure that a template has been saved to the 3D Experience Platform.

You can use a file path to skip needing to navigate through a hidden folder or you can turn on hidden folders to be able to navigate through the whole file path.

To be able to navigate through hidden folders, open up your file explorer and turn on show hidden items; located under the view options.

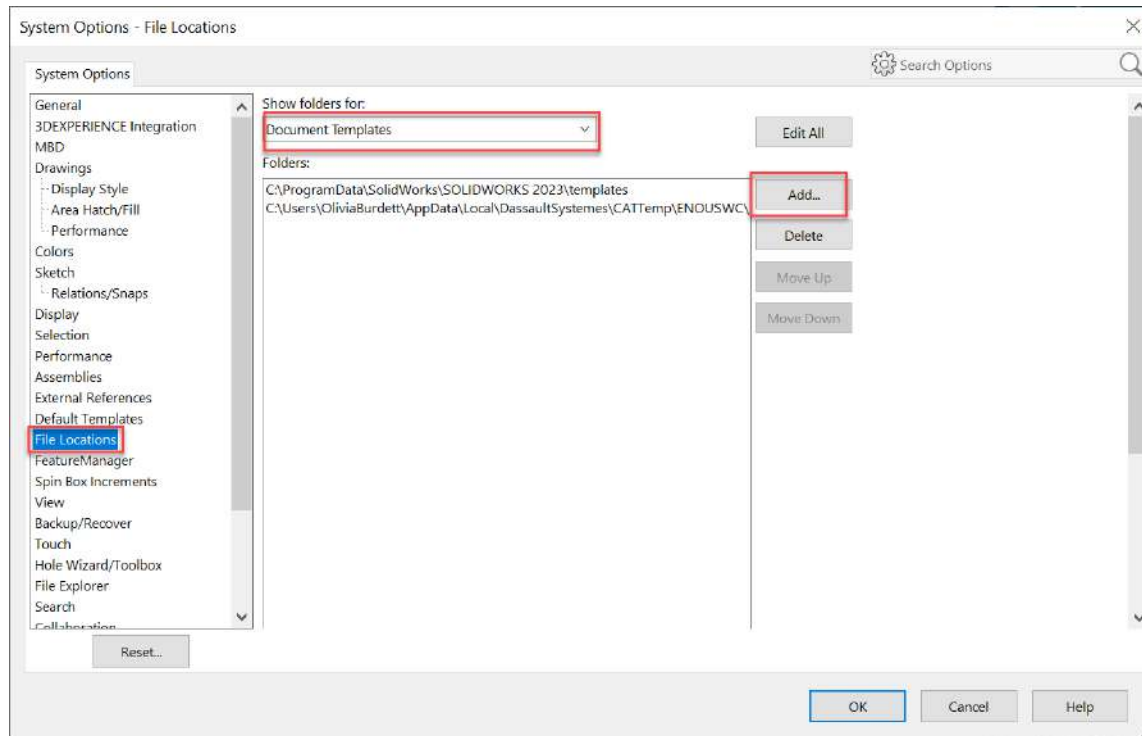


Next open Solidworks and open up the options menu



Opens the Options dialog box. You can customize System Options that affect all documents, or Document Properties that apply ...

Go to File Location and switch the drop down to show folders for: “Document Templates”. Then click “Add”



Now copy and paste the following file path;

`%homepath%\appdata\local\DassaultSystemes\CATTemp\ENOUSWC\Resources`

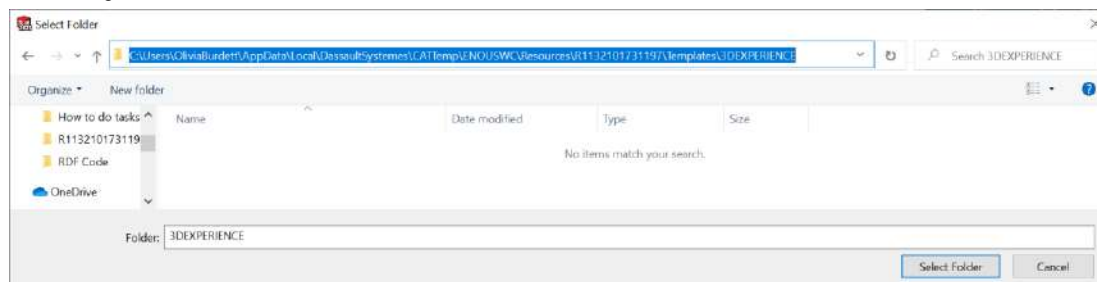
Then finish navigating to the correct folder before clicking select folder; the R_number is company specific

`“R_number”\Templates\3DEXPERIENCE`

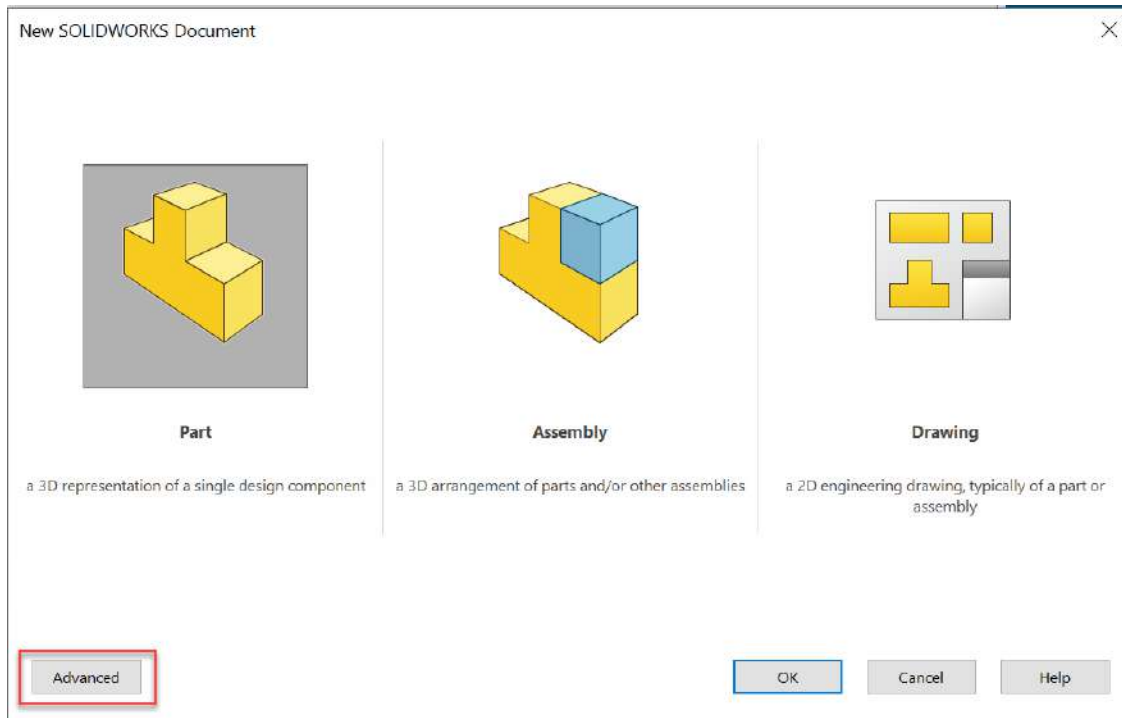
Or you can follow the file path below; your_User is user specific.

`C:\Users\“your_User”\AppData\Local\DassaultSystemes\CATTemp\ENOUSWC\Resources\“R_number”\Templates\3DEXPERIENCE`

Once you are in the folder “3DEXPERIENCE” Click Select folder



Now you should be able to open templates saved to the Cloud. Templates on the cloud appear under the advanced button when creating a new Solidworks Document.



Templates saved on the cloud appear under the 3DExperience tab.
