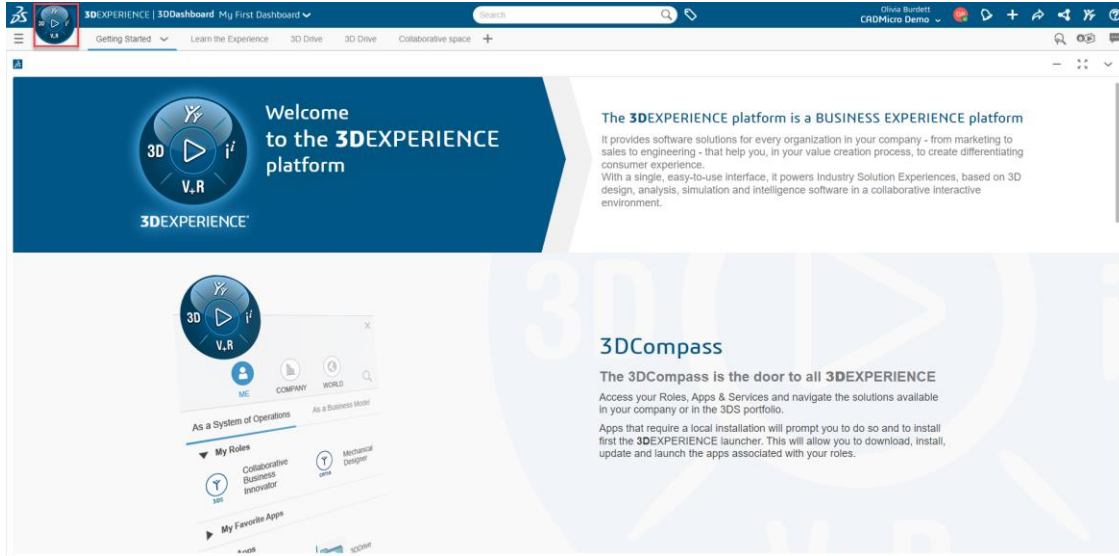
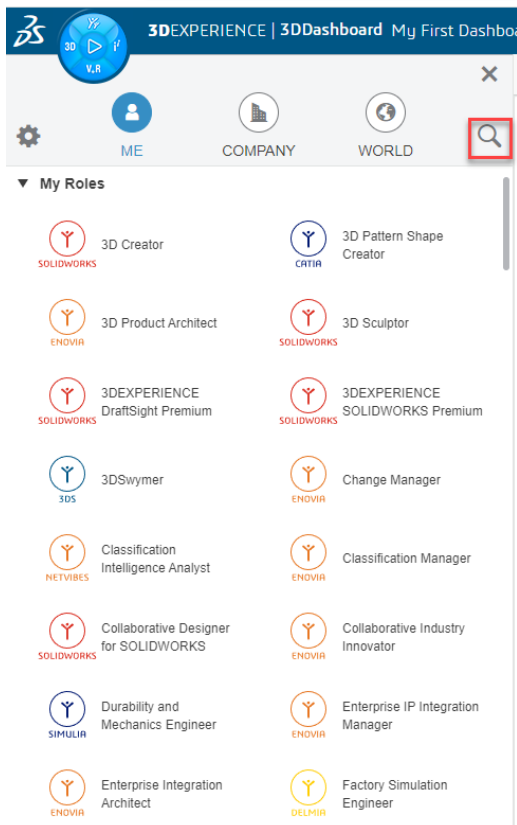


How To Open Catia Files Using 3D Experience

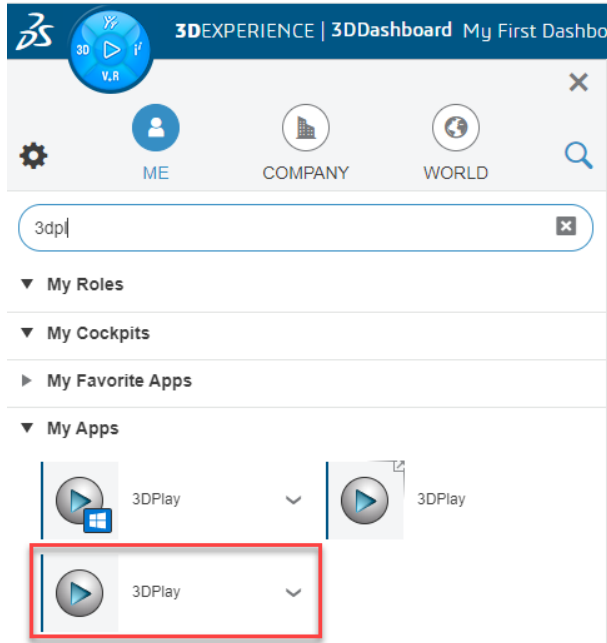
1. Login to you 3D Experience Platform
2. Open the compass



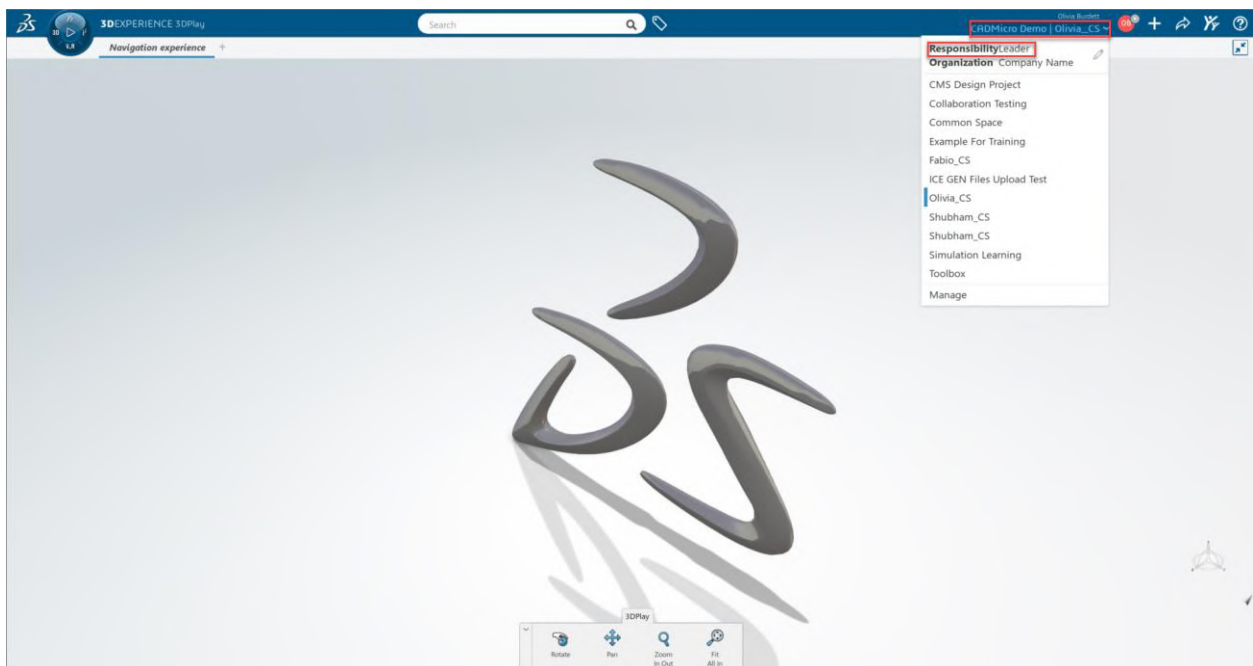
3. Use the search to find 3DPlay



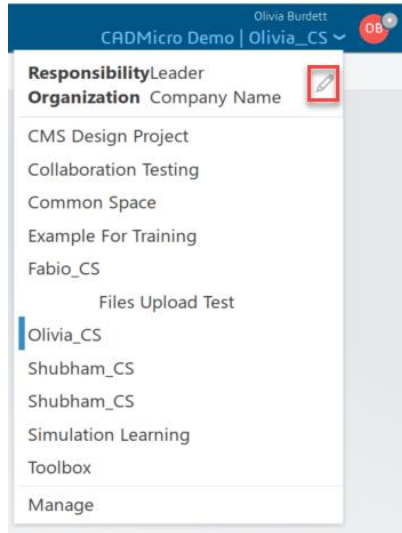
4. Launch the native 3D Play app (No arrow in the corner)



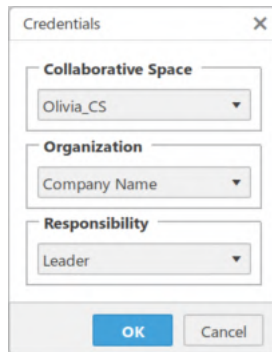
- a. If you don't already have this app installed you will need to install it. Choose to install all granted Roles.
5. Make sure you are working with Author or Leader Responsibility in your collaborative space. You will not be able to import a file working with Owner permissions. Click the drop down arrow below your name to see the permissions you are using.



a. To Change your responsibility click the pencil icon



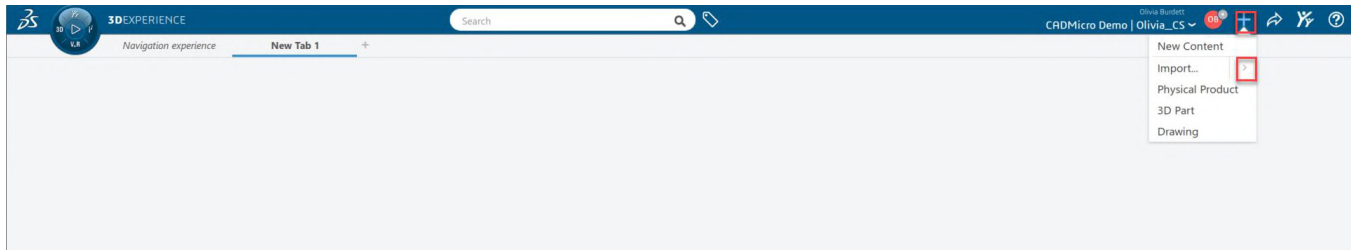
b. Then use the dropdown menus to set your responsibility



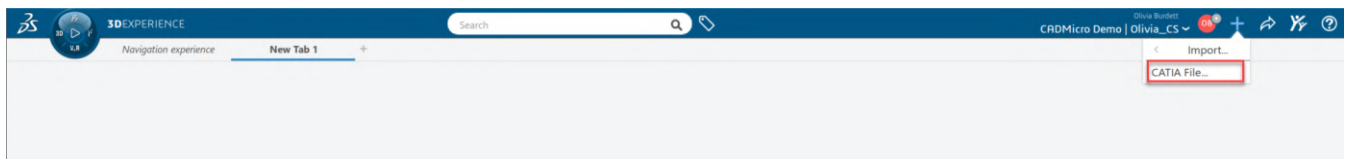
6. Open a new tab



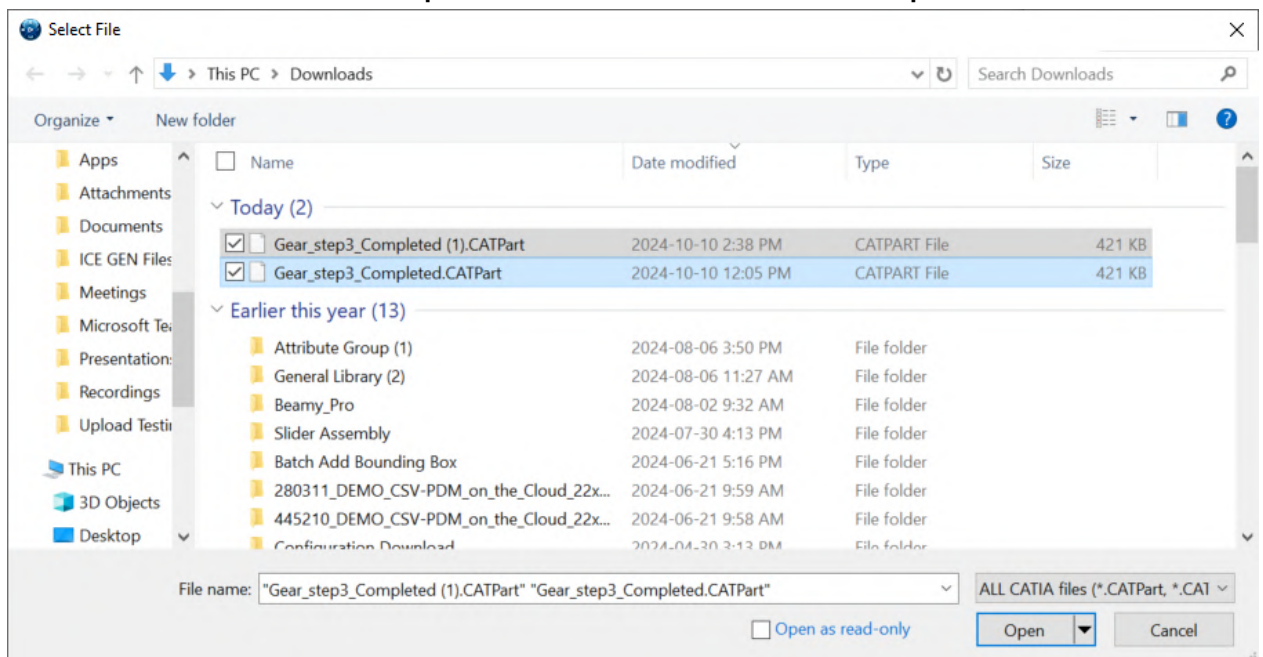
- Click the plus icon in the top right next to your name, then click the arrow beside import.



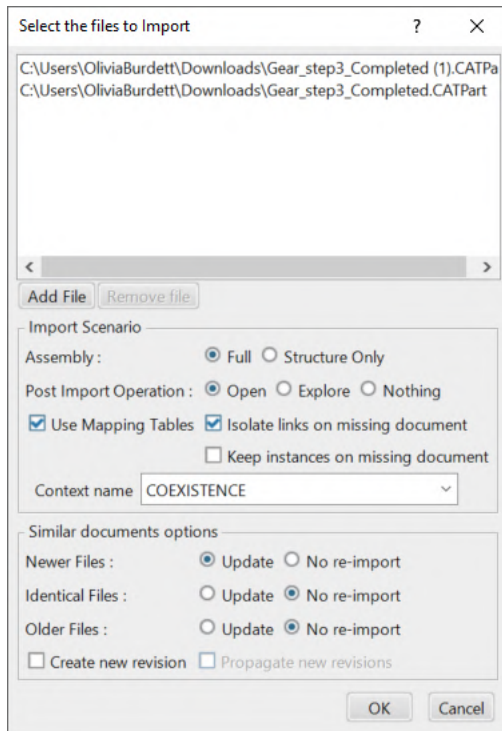
- Then click CATIA File...



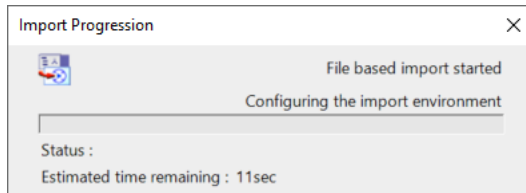
- Your file explorer will open and you will need to navigate to the Catia Files. You can select multiple files at a time. Then click open.



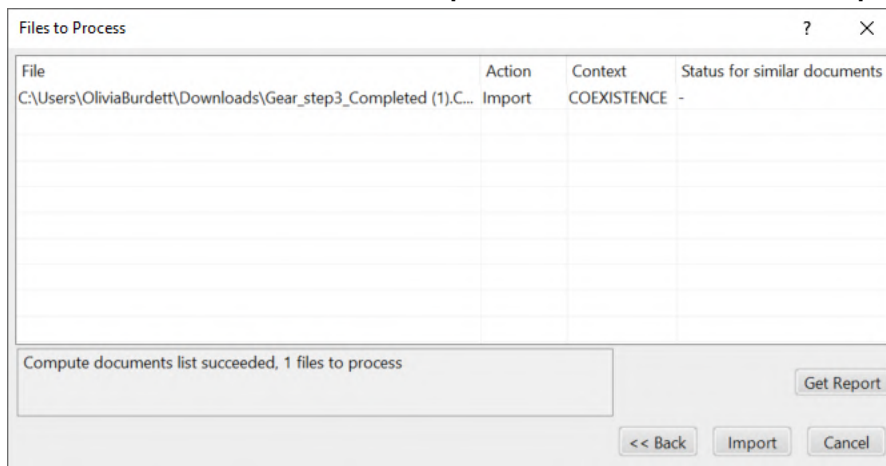
10. Next you need to set your import options. I just left all the default options. And Click Ok



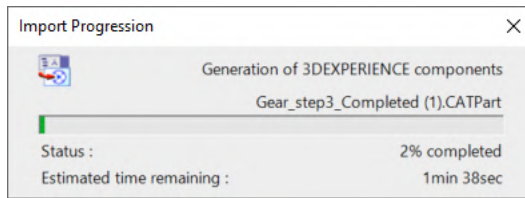
11. The import Process will start.



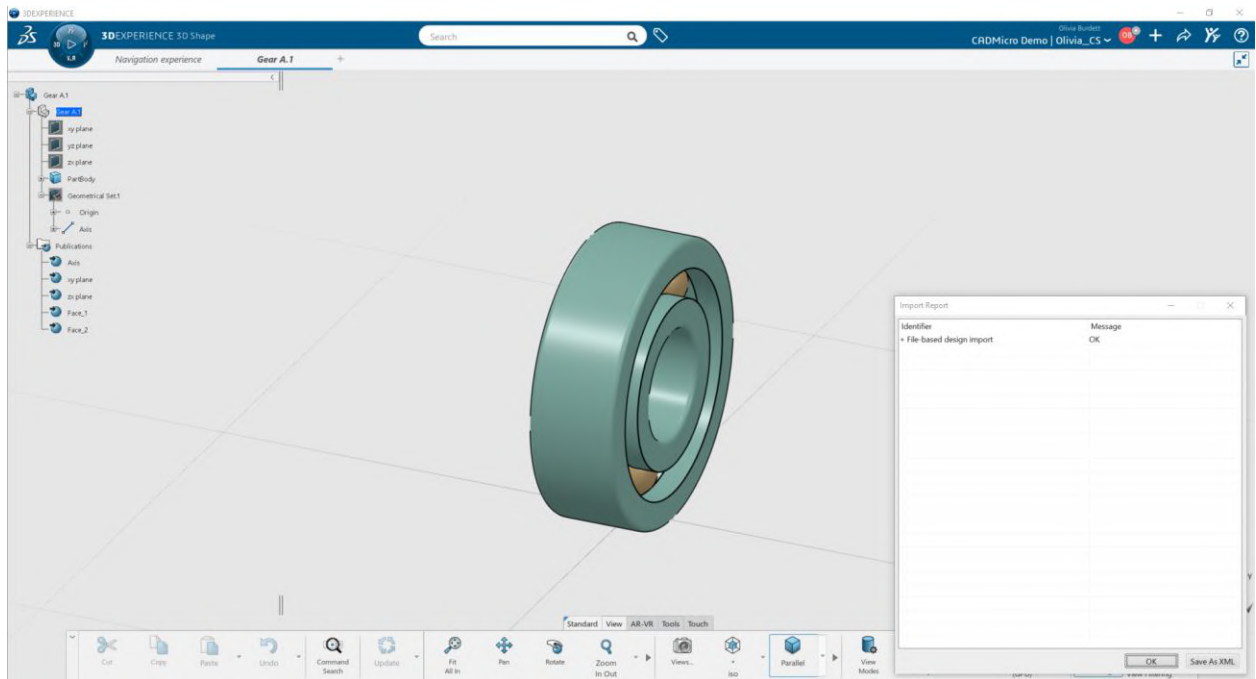
12. You will see a list of files to process. And can click import.



13. The Catia File will be imported to your 3D Experience Platform.

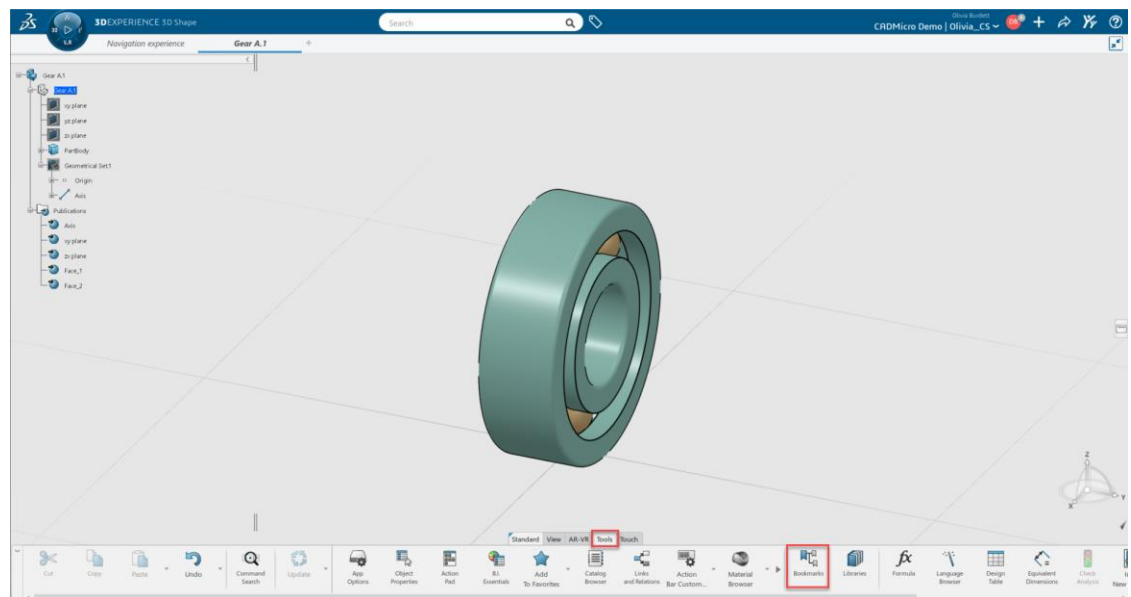


14. The Catia File will open once it has finished being imported.

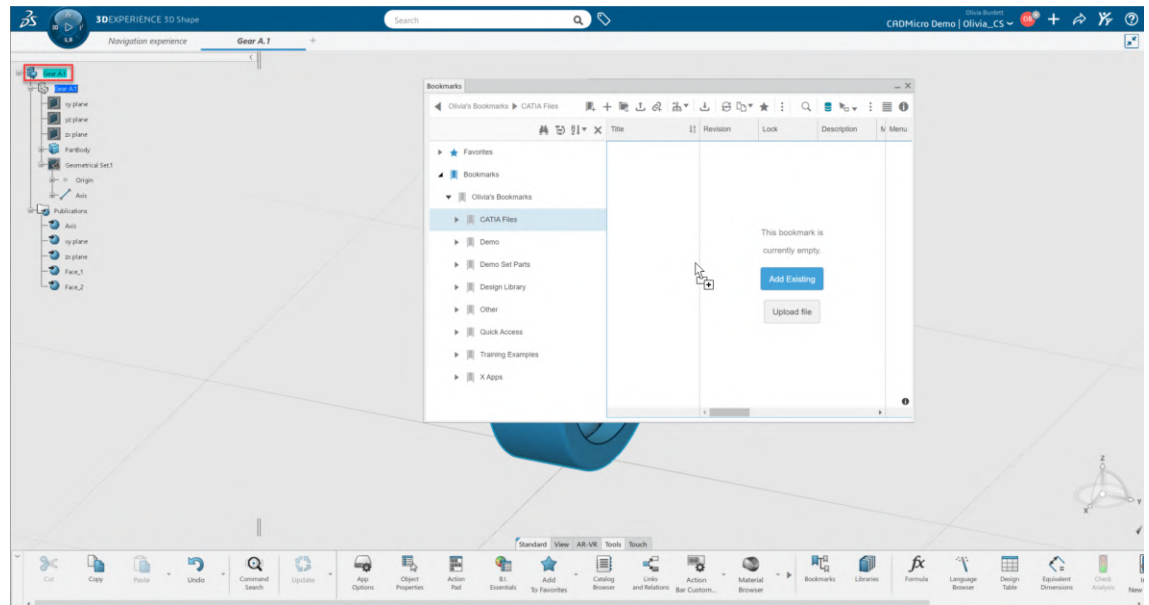


15. The file has now been saved to your 3D experience platform. You can save this file to a bookmark to make it easier to find later.
