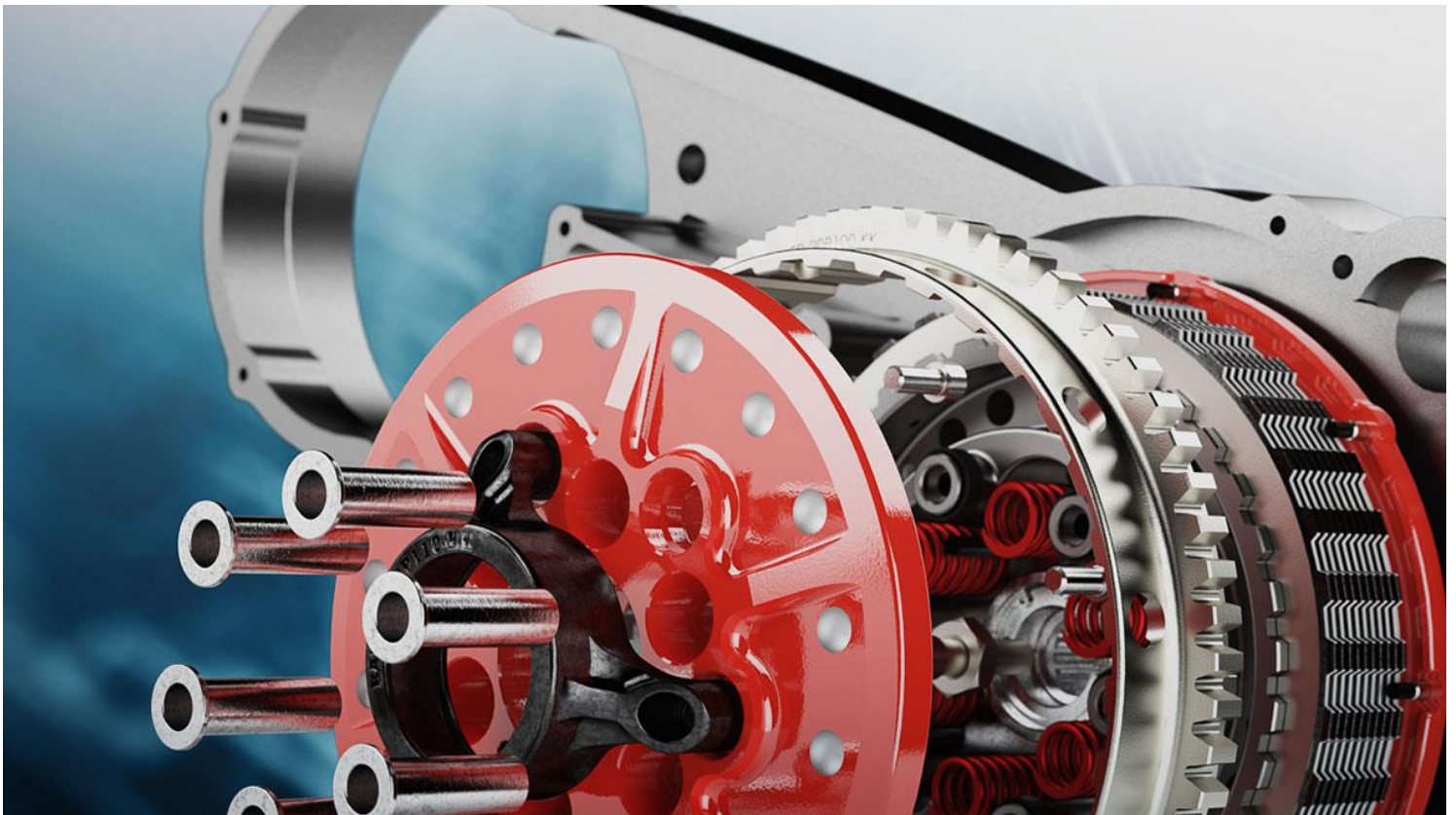

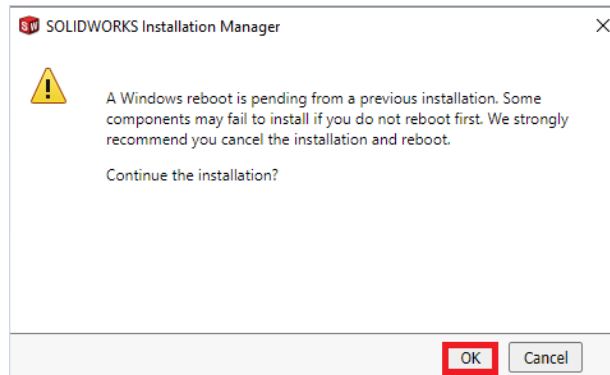

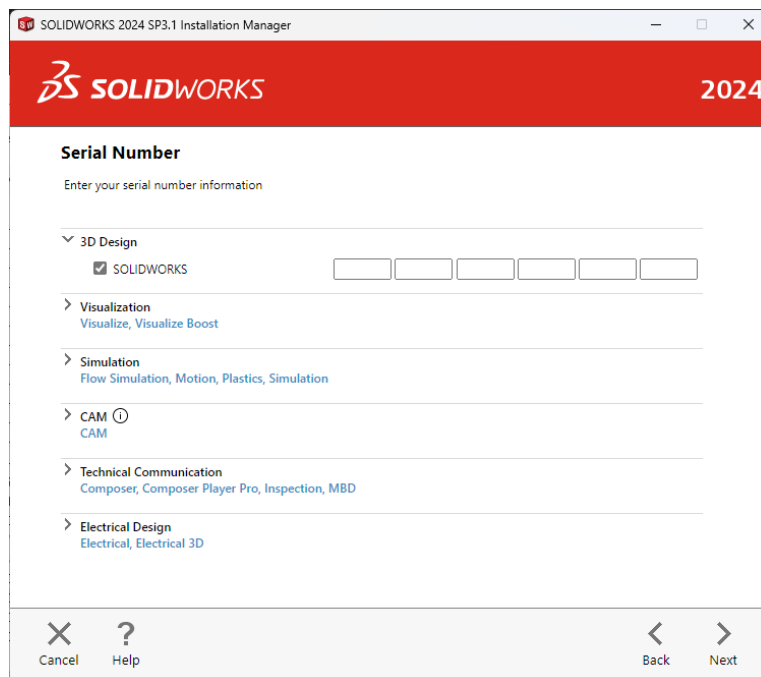
1. Login and Download SolidWorks: <https://www.solidworks.com/sw/support/downloads.htm>
 - a. *Note: You will need a 3DEXPERIENCE ID to access the downloads on this page. Please use your company email when creating this account.*

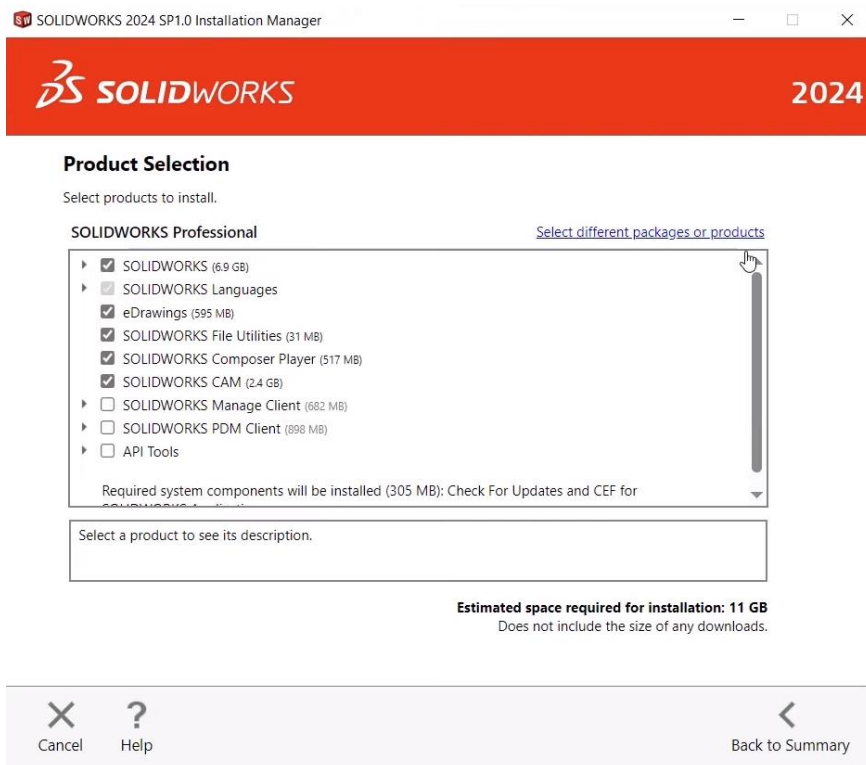
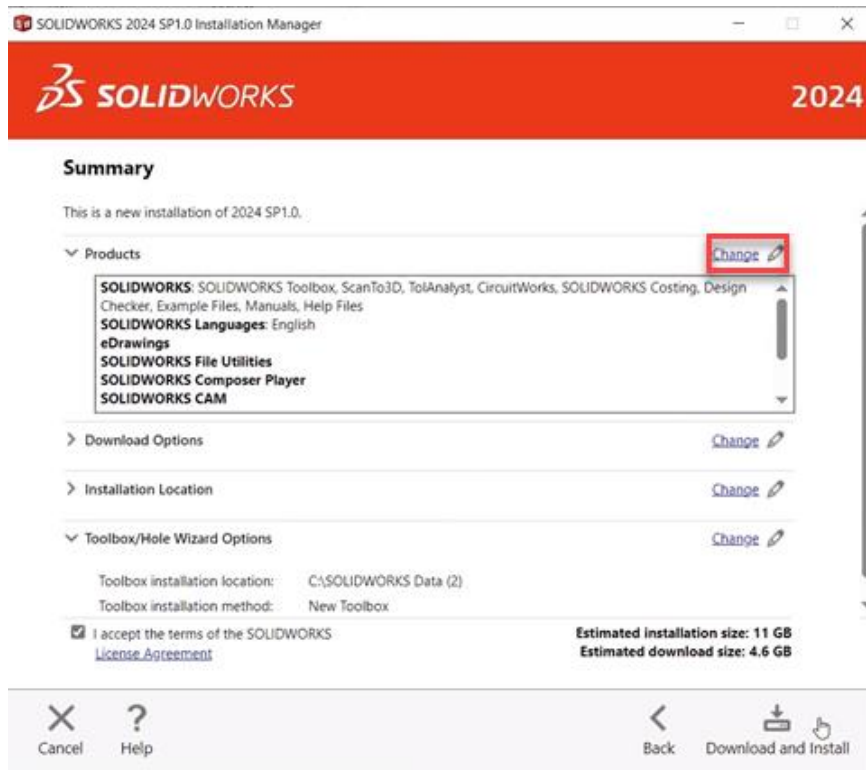
2. Launch SolidWorksSetup.exe.
3. Unzip the file.
4. The SolidWorks Installation Manager will launch on its own. If a message about a pending Windows Reboot pops up, click “OK”.



5. Select “Install on this computer” and click “Next”.
6. Enter the serial numbers for the product(s) you wish to install, then click “Next”.

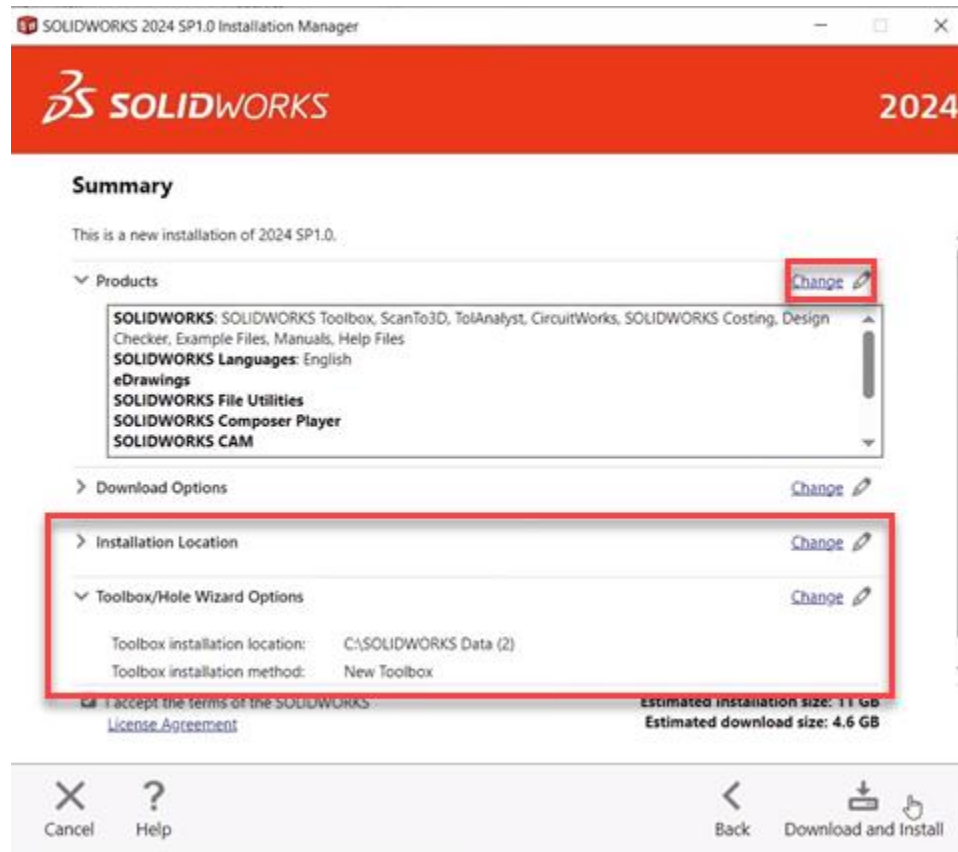


- On the next screen, click “Change” beside “Products” if you wish to install other SolidWorks Add-ins.



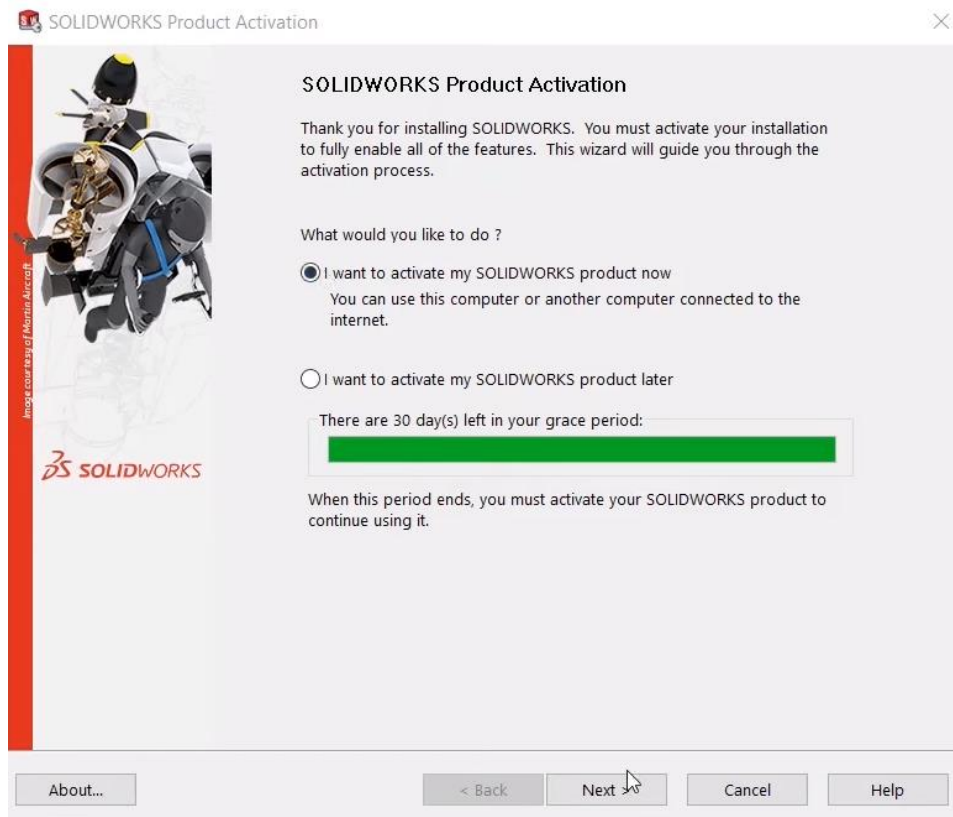
*Note: If you do not see your desired add-in, you may click “Select different packages or products”
These products will require activation to be usable.*

8. Once you have selected the desired add-ins, click “Back to Summary”.
9. Confirm your Installation and Toolbox location. The default is sufficient for most cases.



10. After accepting the terms of the License Agreement, click “Download and Install”.

- Once the download is finished, you will get this message from the Activation Manager when launching SolidWorks for the first time. Select “I want to activate my SOLIDWORKS product now” and click “Next”.



- A list of all the products being activated will display. Select “Automatically over the internet”, enter your email in the field and click “Next”.
- The program will activate and launch SolidWorks afterwards.
